KEY DATES

December 12, 2020: VIRTUAL EdFEST – the citywide public school fair

December 14, 2020: Lottery application opens

February 1, 2021: **APPLICATION DEADLINE** (Grades 9-12)

March 1, 2021: **APPLICATION DEADLINE** (PK3 – Grade 8)

April 2, 2021: Lottery results are available

May 3, 2021: Enrollment deadline for matched students



WHAT IS MY SCHOOL DC?

My School DC is the common application and public school lottery for DC Public Schools (DCPS) and the majority of DC public charter schools (PK3 – Grade 12). Families can apply to up to 12 schools using one application and participate in a single, random lottery.

HOW DO I APPLY?

The My School DC application is an online-only application available at MySchoolDC.org. The lottery is random so there is no advantage to applying first; however, applicants must apply by the application deadlines.

WHO NEEDS TO APPLY?

Submit a My School DC application if your child will be a **NEW** student at a:

- PK3 or PK4 program at any DCPS school, including your DCPS in-boundary school
- DCPS school outside your boundary or feeder pattern for any grade (PK3 – Grade 12), including a DCPS citywide school
- DCPS selective high school or program (Grades 9-12)
- Participating public charter school (PK3 – Grade 12)

WHO DOES NOT NEED TO APPLY?

You do **NOT** need to submit a My School DC application if your child will:

- Remain in their current school (contact school to re-enroll)
- Attend their DCPS in-boundary school (Grades K-12)
