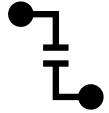

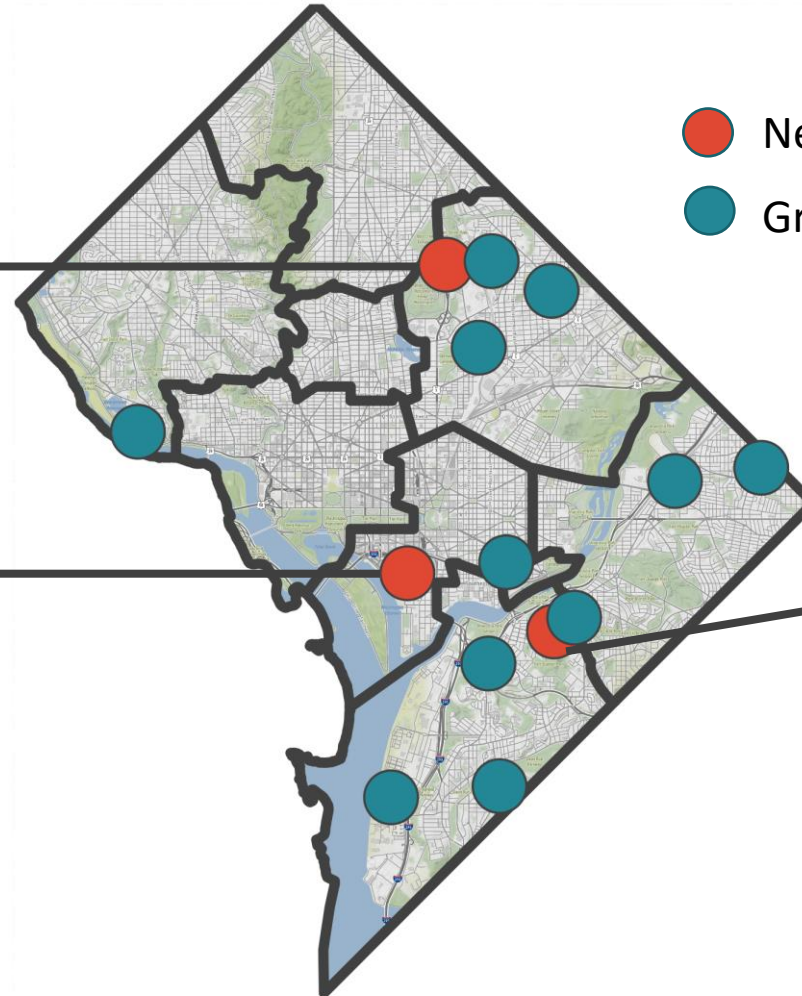


School Changes in SY24-25

Three new campuses and 11 new grades are slated to open in the coming school year.

Washington Yu Ying PCS is expanding their existing campus to a new facility down the block that will serve PK3, PK4, and Kindergarten.

AppleTree Early Learning PCS – Waterfront Station will open as a new campus for PK3 & PK4 students.

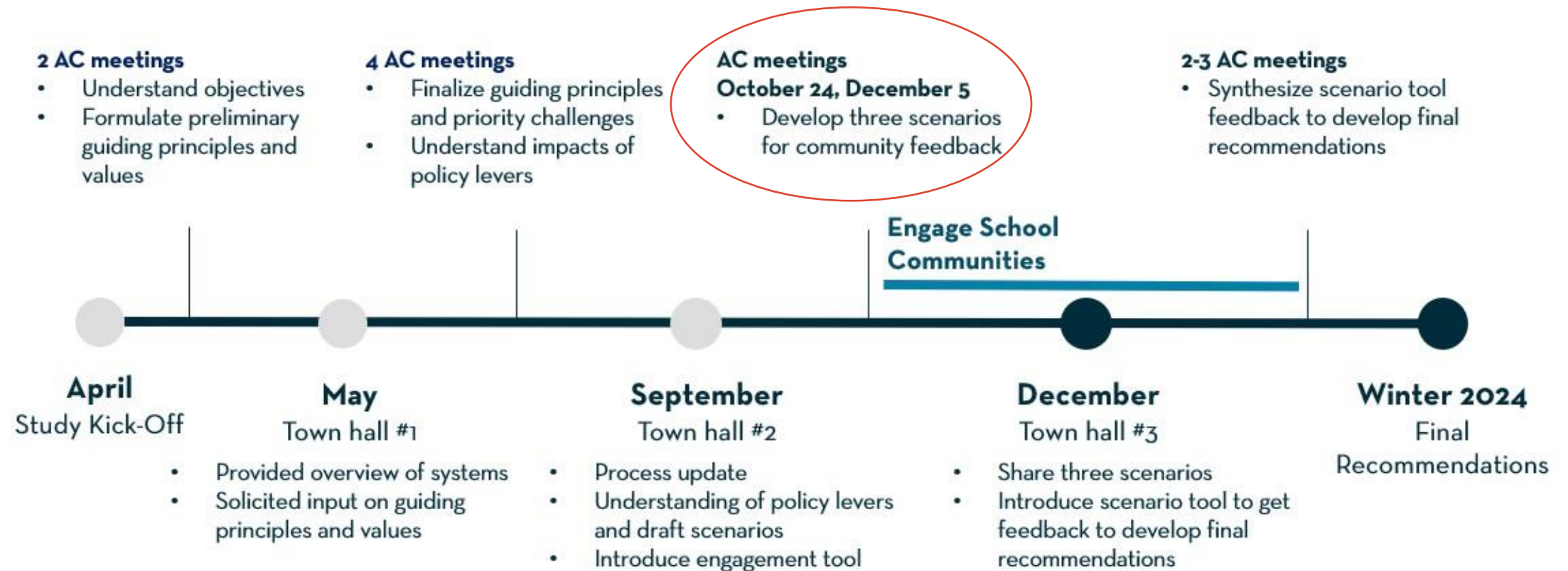

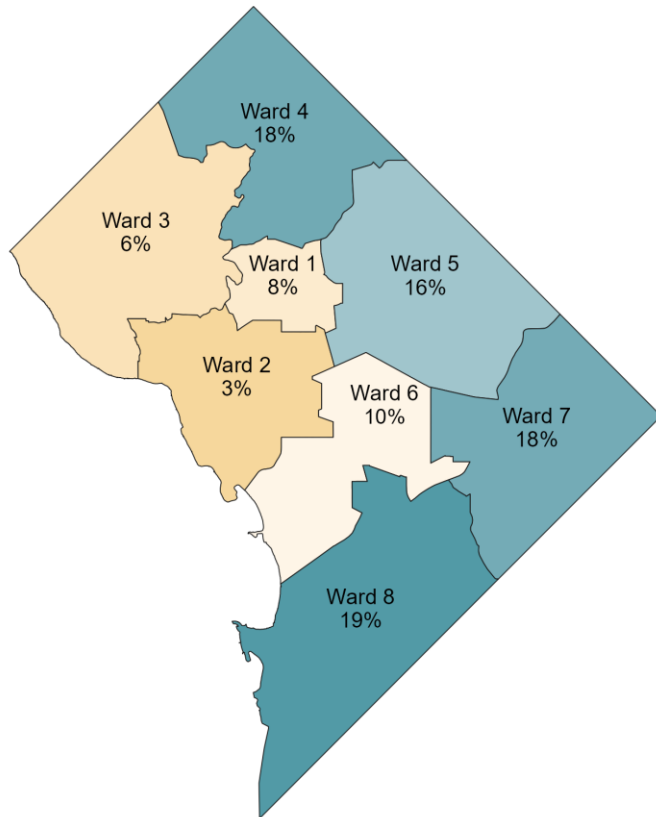




WARD PARITY GOAL

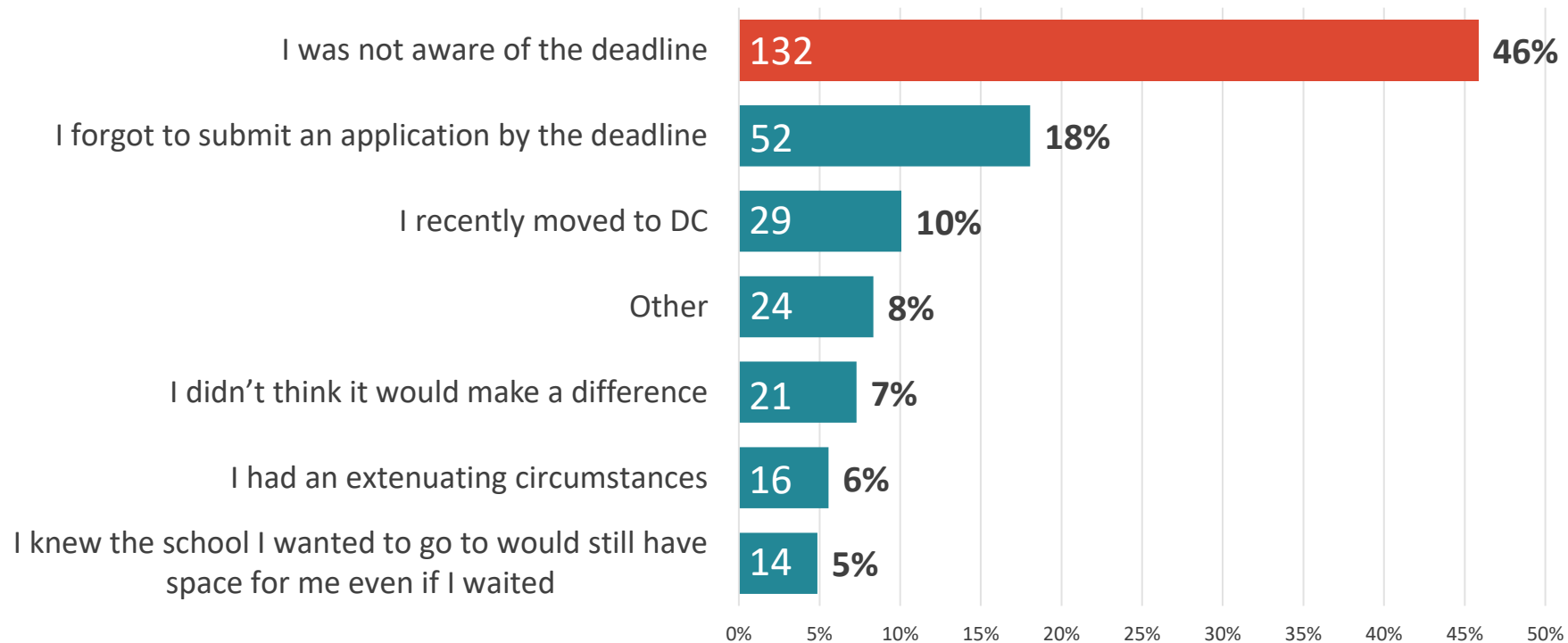

Q. Can you share your reason for submitting an application after the deadline?

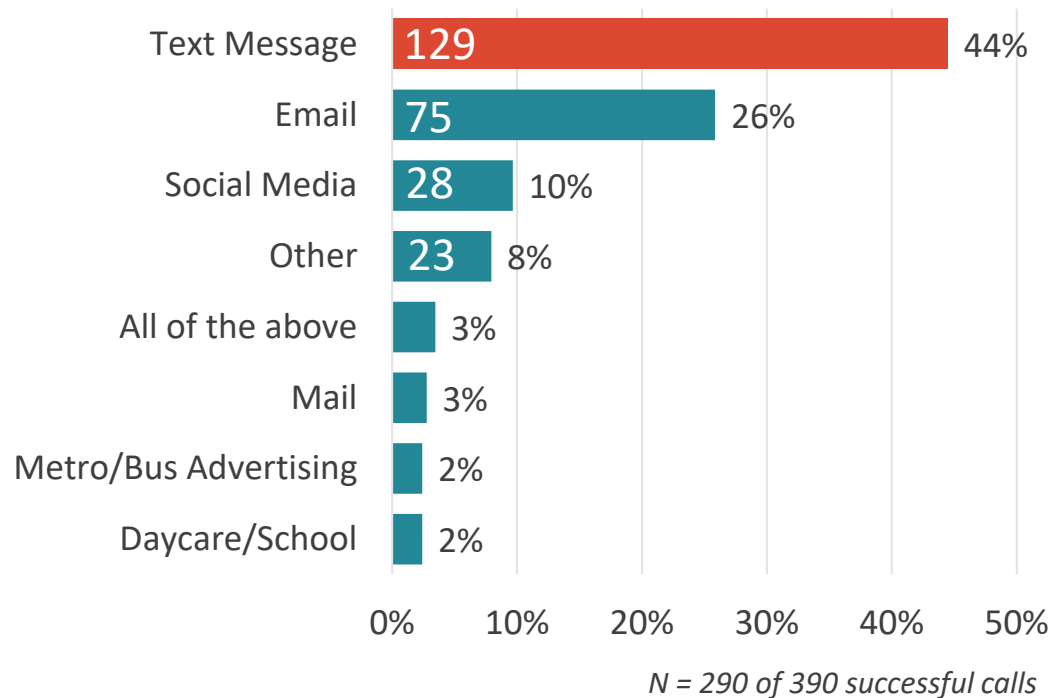


N = 288 of 390 successful calls

Text & Email Preferred

Electronic methods continue to be the most preferred way to receive information.

**Q. What's the best way to reach you & friends
with lottery deadline information?**



81% of contacted applicants shared that knowing the deadline would have encouraged them to apply by the deadline.
