

EdFEST 2023: A Successful Return to In-Person

- 8,007 total attendees recorded entering; beating 2018's 7,350 attendees for a new attendee record!
- 750 free meals were distributed by DC Central Kitchen at the PK3 Grade 8 event.
- 333 vaccines were administered between the two events.






EdFEST 2023: Reaching our Target Wards

For the first time for an in-person EdFEST, we tracked registrations by Ward using Attendease with 2,493 family registrants for PK3 – Grade 8.












EdFEST 2023: Reaching our Target Wards

EdFEST 2023 Survey Results

Overall attendee satisfaction was higher compared to our virtual events, while lower at Grade $9 - 12^{th}$ due to space concerns.



Reviewing 2023: Where did Total Applicants land by the Deadline?




- In 2023, the number of unique applicants increased by +3% (+701).
- Compared to pre-COVID trends, unique applicants were still down -10% (-2,286).



Reviewing 2023: How Many Applicants applied to Entry Grades?


Only 9th grade saw a small increase (+162, +4%) over last year, with Elementary Grades remaining steady to 2022.




The Public School Lottery

Overall applicant numbers are up 2% (+214) relative to the same day last year.








SY23-24 SY24-25



Application Trends – Transition Grades


9th Grade is up 9% (+156) compared to this day last year, raising additional questions:




School Changes in SY24-25
