
Boundary Study Implementation

My School DC worked in partnership with DCPS and OCTO to implement the upcoming boundary changes. Fun Fact: of the 147,707 addresses within our application, approximately 11,000 (7%) addresses will have one school option change.



School Finder will update to display SY25-26 boundaries on November 14th.

On Step 3, applicant's by-right school choices will now be identified as either their In-Boundary, Feeder Pattern, or Boundary Phase In Right.


