The KIDS Mobile Medical Clinic/Ronald McDonald Care Mobile® is a service of MedStar Georgetown University Hospital, Division of Community Pediatrics. Staffed by members of the Georgetown University School of Medicine faculty, the KIDS Mobile Medical Clinic/Ronald McDonald Care Mobile® provides quality, on-the-spot mobile medical care for children up to 21 years of age.

Who is Eligible?

- Children with no insurance
- Children with Medicaid and no regular doctor or clinic
- Children ages 0 to 21 years

Do I Need an Appointment?

- If your child needs a checkup or shots, an appointment is required. Please call or drop by the Mobile Clinic to schedule one.
- If your child is sick, you do not need an appointment. Your child can be seen at any of our locations.
